The Government of Sindh has received a loan from the World Bank for Reconstruction and Development towards the cost of Sindh Education Reform Program(SERP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for Public Private Partnership in Education "PPRS".

Sindh Government is committed to provide quality education to the most underserved of the province. Under the Public Private Partnership, the Government has launched a pilot initiative for the promotion of 1,000 private schools in 10 districts of Sindh Province. The project spearheaded by the Sindh Education Foundation (SEF). The project being implemented in the following districts:

Khairpur, Larkana, Kamber-Shahdadkot, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Sanghar, Badin, Thatta, Umerkot, and Mithi.

One of the key components of this project is to provide Quality Education, therefore to improving student's sport & recreations activity we are inviting bid for different kind of material for 385 schools, in which different kind of sports kits are demanding, details are available in bidding documents.

SEF intends to engage the services of the reputable organizations/companies which have expertise/capabilities to supply of large quantity of material (sports and recreational items). Companies that have expertise/capabilities of 5 years in their field along with the turnover of Rs.30 million per annum may participate.

Bidding Document may be obtained from Procurement Department, SEF @ Rs. 1,000/- (non-refundable) per document in form of DD/PO etc in favor of Sindh Education Foundation.

Bid submission date is June 21^{st} 2013 by 3.00 Noon sharp. Bid would be opened in presence of bidders during the same day at 3.15 P.M.

Please note that Contract Award shall be made to lowest evaluated bid, which is responsive to the quality criteria of the document.
